Anglicare Victoria's TEACHaR Program has made a huge difference to the education of vulnerable children and young people for almost a decade. While first developed for young people in out-of-home care, it has grown to support students, carers and professionals all across Victoria.

TEACHaR meets the educational needs of all vulnerable children and young people (4-18 yrs old).

Education Specialists (teachers) work collaboratively with children and young people, their carers/parents, school staff and other professionals to transform their feelings and attitudes towards learning. By creating a positive environment towards learning, this personalised program helps to:

Increase school engagement and attendance.



Improve literacy, numeracy, personal and social capabilities.



Provide one on one teaching and learning based on student's voice, interests and needs.



Deliver a trauma informed, strengths based teaching approach.



Develop collaborative partnerships with schools, Care Teams and other stakeholders.



Provide a flexible learning environment including home, school and online.



Advocate for our students to achieve their best possible outcomes.



Design individually tailored Personal Education Plans (PEPs) with realistic, attainable educational goals.



Develop positive relationships to establish rapport and trust.
