EVENT:	DATE:	BRIEF DESCRIPTION:
MIDSUMMA CARNIVAL	JANUARY 22	An iconic outdoor celebration which highlights the opening of the Midsumma Festival each year.
MIDSUMMA FESTIVAL	JANUARY 21 – FEBRUARY 12	Australia's LGBTIQ+ cultural festival, celebrating queer artists and cultural diversity through curating queer cultural experiences.
MIDSUMMA PRIDE MARCH	FEBRUARY 5	A parade to celebrate solidarity in sexuality and gender diversity.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSGENDER DAY OF VISIBILITY	MARCH 31	A day celebrated to bring awareness to transgender people and their identities as well as recognise those that helped fight for rights for transgender people.
INTERNATIONAL LESBIAN VISIBILITY DAY	APRIL 26	An annual day to celebrate, recognise and bring visibility to Lesbians.
INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST HOMOPHOBIA, BIPHOBIA, INTERSEXISM AND TRANSPHOBIA (IDAHOBIT)	MAY 17	An annual day to raise awareness of the violence and discrimination against LGBTIQ+ communities worldwide.
PANSEXUAL VISIBILITY DAY	MAY 24	Annual day to promote awareness of and celebrate pansexual and panromantic identities.
INTERNATIONAL NON-BINARY PEOPLE'S DAY	JULY 14	A day aimed to celebrate the rich diversity of gender and celebrate people who do not fit into a binary gender.
WEAR IT PURPLE DAY	AUGUST 25	A day to foster supportive, safe, empowering and inclusive environments for rainbow young people.
INTERNATIONAL CELEBRATE BISEXUALITY DAY	SEPTEMBER 23	A day observed annually to recognise and celebrate bisexual people, the bisexual community and the history of bisexuality.
INTERNATIONAL PRONOUNS DAY	OCTOBER 18	A day which seeks to make respecting, sharing and educating about personal pronouns, commonplace.
ASEXUAL AWARENESS WEEK	OCTOBER 23 - OCTOBER 29	A week to promote awareness of those on the asexual spectrum.
INTERSEX AWARENESS DAY	OCTOBER 26	An internationally observed day designed to highlight human rights issues faced by intersex people.
INTERSEX DAY OF REMEMBRANCE (INTERSEX SOLIDARITY DAY)	NOVEMBER 8	An awareness day which marks the birth of Herculine Barbin which aims to draw attention to the issues faced by members of the intersex community.
TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE	NOVEMBER 20	A day to honour the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of anti-transgender violence.
WORLD AIDS DAY	DECEMBER 1	A day dedicated to raising awareness of the AIDS pandemic and honouring the memory of those who lost their lives.
