<b>MIDSUMMA CARNIVAL</b>	<b>JANUARY 21</b>	An iconic outdoor celebration which highlights the opening of the Midsumma Festival each year.
<b>MIDSUMMA FESTIVAL</b>	<b>JANUARY 21 – FEBRUARY 11</b>	Australia’s LGBTIQA+ cultural festival, celebrating queer artists and cultural diversity through curating queer cultural experiences..
<b>MIDSUMMA PRIDE MARCH</b>	<b>FEBRUARY 4</b>	A parade to celebrate solidarity in sexuality and gender diversity.
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSGENDER DAY OF VISIBILITY</b>	<b>MARCH 31</b>	A day celebrated to bring awareness to transgender people and their identities as well as recognise those that helped fight for rights for transgender people.
<b>INTERNATIONAL LESBIAN VISIBILITY DAY</b>	<b>APRIL 26</b>	A day to celebrate, recognise and bring visibility to Lesbians.
<b>INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST HOMOPHOBIA, BIPHOBIA, INTERSEX DISCRIMINATION AND TRANSPHOBIA (IDAHOBIT)</b>	<b>MAY 17</b>	A day to raise awareness of the violence and discrimination against LGBTIQA+ communities worldwide.
<b>PANSEXUAL VISIBILITY DAY</b>	<b>MAY 24</b>	A day to promote awareness of and celebrate pansexual and panromantic identities.
<b>INTERNATIONAL NON-BINARY PEOPLE’S DAY</b>	<b>JULY 14</b>	A day aimed to raise awareness to the issues faced by non-binary people.
<b>WEAR IT PURPLE DAY</b>	<b>AUGUST 30</b>	A day to foster supportive, safe, empowering and inclusive environments for rainbow young people.
<b>INTERNATIONAL CELEBRATE BISEXUALITY DAY</b>	<b>SEPTEMBER 23</b>	A day observed to recognise and celebrate bisexual people, the bisexual community and the history of bisexuality.
<b>INTERNATIONAL PRONOUNS DAY</b>	<b>OCTOBER 16</b>	A day which seeks to make respecting, sharing and educating about personal pronouns, commonplace.
<b>ASEXUAL AWARENESS WEEK</b>	<b>OCTOBER 21 - OCTOBER 27</b>	A week to promote awareness of those on the asexual spectrum.
<b>INTERSEX AWARENESS DAY</b>	<b>OCTOBER 26</b>	A day designed to highlight human rights issues faced by intersex people.
<b>INTERSEX DAY OF REMEMBRANCE (INTERSEX SOLIDARITY DAY)</b>	<b>NOVEMBER 8</b>	An awareness day which marks the birth of Herculine Barbin which aims to draw attention to the issues faced by members of the intersex community.
<b>TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE</b>	<b>NOVEMBER 20</b>	A day to honour the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of anti-transgender violence.
<b>WORLD AIDS DAY</b>	<b>DECEMBER 1</b>	A day dedicated to raising awareness of the AIDS pandemic and honouring the memory of those who lost their lives.
